Alina Lodge and Haley House are taking a proactive stance to protect student, resident, employee and visitor health. We are working to address people's uncertainty and apprehension as well as to contribute to public health efforts to be able to continue our important addiction treatment services.

We have adopted internal measures to reduce environmental risk and prepare for various contingencies. These include policies around infection prevention practices, and environmental disinfection routines. Our policies, procedures and decisions will be based on facts provided by local and state agencies, as well as, the recommendations of the CDC and WHO. Please understand that this is an evolving situation and we will continue to update all policies and procedures as necessary.

The CDC has released preventive measures in order to help control the potential spread of COVID-19. We are asking everyone's assistance in order to maintain a healthy environment for not only our students but for our staff and visitors to our facility.

Please adhere to the following recommendations:

1. If a visitor has a fever or any symptoms of cold, flu, or other respiratory illness, they are not to visit the campus of Alina Lodge or Haley House.
2. If a visitor or someone with whom they live has recently traveled to a region identified by the CDC as impacted by the coronavirus (see the CDC Travel Watch list at the link below), they should not visit the campus of Alina Lodge or Haley House.
3. If a visitor has been exposed to somebody diagnosed with the coronavirus, they should not visit the campus of Alina Lodge or Haley House.
4. If anyone develops symptoms or is diagnosed after visiting Alina Lodge or Haley House, they should let us know so that we can take any steps necessary to protect others.
